## **NEVADA STATE BARBER'S HEALTH and SANITATION BOARD**



### **Minutes --August 6, 2017 -- Regular Business Meeting & Public Hearing**

President Nathaniel LaShore called the meeting to order on Sunday, August 6, 2017, the time was 3:02 P.M. at the Masterpiece Barber College, located at 3510 East Bonanza Road, Las Vegas, Nevada.

Board members Ms. Nancy Hathaway, Mr. Nathaniel LaShore, Mr. Ihsan Azzam, and Ms. Antinette Maestas. Ms. JoAnna Wesley-Winn was absent.

The agenda was reviewed and approved as posted.

Ms. Hathaway made a motion to dispense of the reading of the minutes for the April 2, 2017, since everyone had copies and they had been read. The motion included to accept the minutes as submitted. Mr. Azzam seconded the motion and all was in favor.

Ms. Hathaway made a motion to dispense of the reading of the financial reports since everyone has a copy and read the reports. This is the reports for the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> quarter 2016-2017. Mr. Azzam seconded and all was in favor.

#### **Officers Report**

1. Ms. Hathaway reported that she has been busy up North. Doing a lot of inspecting, the North is looking for a new inspector. The current inspector wants to retire.
2. Mr. LaShore reported that he has been doing business as usual. He's been out inspecting and notes that it's never a dull moment.
3. Ms. Wesley-Winn was not in attendance for meeting or for testing.

#### **New Business**

**Jay Vernor** -- Mr. Vernor came before the Board to be able to exam in the State of Nevada. He does have a felony on his record. The felony was in 2011 and he was discharged on August 31, 2015. The felony was for possession of marijuana. Ms. Hathaway made a motion to allow Mr. Vernor to attend a 250

hour refresher course and then be able to exam in Nevada providing he has a random drug test. Mr. Azzam seconded the motion and all was in favor.

**Manuel Chaidez** hearing – Mr. Chaidez came before the Board to be able to attend barber school and he has a felony on his record. The felony was for attempt sexual assault. He went to prison from 2012-2015. He was discharged on October 8, 2015. He and the female were juveniles and he got charged as an adult. They were both 15 when this happened. There was alcohol and drugs involved when this happened. He is a registered sex offender. Ms. Hathaway suggests that Mr. Chaidez return with more paperwork. Mr. Chaidez will need to return to the next hearing on October 1, 2017. He needs to write a letter requesting to a new hearing by September 1, 2017.

**Robert Ramos** hearing – Mr. Ramos came before the Board to be able to attend school. The felony was in 2008 and in 2012 he was discharged. The felony was commercial burglary. While in prison he got his GED, he was fighting fires in fire camps, he sings in the church choir, and is working marketing selling time shares. Ms. Hathaway made a motion to allow Mr. Ramos to be able to attend barber school, Mr. Azzam seconded the motion and all was in favor.

**Joel Serrano** hearing – Mr. Serrano came before the Board to be able to attend Barber School. He has two felonies on his record. In 2002 convicted of burglary he was on probation. In 2013 his son stole a candy bar from Walmart. He took the charge so that his son would not have anything on his record. He had to pay a fine of \$1000.00. There was no probation if the fine was paid. He is married with 2 children. Ms. Hathaway made a motion to allow Mr. Serrano to attend barber school, Mr. Azzam seconded the motion and all was in favor.

**Roger Skinner** hearing – Mr. Skinner came before the Board to be able to attend Barber School. He got a felony in 2002 for aggravated assault. He went to prison in 2003 and was released December 23, 2004. He was on parole for 3 years and completed everything in 2007. His daughter was molested by a family friend and told Mr. Skinner (her Dad), he went to the individual and that was why he got the felony. Ms. Hathaway told Mr. Skinner he did not have the release paperwork and he would have to come back for the October 1, 2017 hearing and produce the paperwork then. Mr. Skinner was told the deadline for this hearing would be September 1, 2017. He must resubmit for a new hearing.

**Eric Marshall** hearing – Mr. Marshall came before the Board to be able to attend Barber School. He got a felony February 8, 2002 for possession with intent to sell. He got 6 months' probation after 2 months he got caught with marijuana and had to go to jail for 4 months. He was released June 19, 2014. Ms. Hathaway made a motion to allow Mr. Marshall to attend barber school providing he do random drug testing, Mr. Azzam seconded the motion and all was in favor.

**Micholas Nealy** hearing – Mr. Nealy came before the Board he had a felony in 2004 for pandering of a child. He has no paperwork. Ms. Ms. Hathaway told Mr. Nealy he did not have the release paperwork and he would have to come back for the October 1, 2017 hearing and produce the paperwork then. Mr. Nealy was told the deadline for this hearing would be September 1, 2017. He must resubmit for a new hearing.

**Kevin Jamerson** hearing – Mr. Jamerson came before the Board for an extension for school he has gone over his 1 year mark. He started school April 13, 2016. As of July 29<sup>th</sup> he had 1342 hours. He has many suspensions and has missed several weeks of school. He claims he had financial hardships. He was asked

why he was off school all last week, he said he was moving. Ms. Hathaway made a motion to allow Mr. Jamerson to finish school and he must take the October 1, 2017, the deadline for that examination is September 15, 2107. He only needs 158 hours to finish. Mr. Azzam seconded the motion and all was in favor.

**Esteban Covarrubias** hearing – Mr. Covarrubias came before the Board for permission to take the next examination. He went over time on his 1 year of school. He was suspended different times for failing an exam. He is finished with his school now. Ms. Hathaway made a motion to allow Mr. Covarrubias to exam. He must exam October 1, 2017 and the deadline for that in September 15, 2017. Mr. Azzam seconded the motion and all was in favor.

**James Scott** - hearing – Mr. Scott came before the Board because his license were in jeopardy for not taking his registered examination. Mr. Scott fell into a financial hardship. He had everything ready to take the last exam but he did not have the money for the exam. Ms. Hathaway made a motion to allow him to keep his license providing he turn everything in by august 11, 2017. Mr. Azzam seconded and all was in favor.

**Adrian Smith** – hearing – Mr. Smith came before the Board because his license were in jeopardy. Mr. Smith has had an application since May. He went and got his TB test and then never went back and had it read. Ms. Maestas sent it back and told him he needed to get it read, and have his employer notarize the portion he was supposed to. He never had any of this done. He claims he got a letter that was sent certified but he never went to pick the letter up. He needs to complete the application. August was the third exam he missed. Ms. Hathaway made a motion to suspend his license, Mr. Assam seconded the motion. All was in favor. Mr. Smith was told he had to submit a new application before September 15, 2017, he was given back his application and money order. He was told he could not work until he takes his registered exam.

**Harold Calamohoy** – hearing – Mr. Calamohoy came before the Board because his license were in jeopardy. Mr. Calamohoy should have taken the June or August exam but he moved and never notified the Board of the new address. The letters were returned. Ms. Hathaway made a motion to allow Mr. Calamohoy to keep his license providing he turns in a completed application by Friday, August 11, 2017. Mr. Azzam seconded the motion and all was in favor.

**Joseph Stull** – hearing – Mr. Stull was not present. He was issued an apprentice license 6/18/15 with an expiration on 12/18/16. He should have taken the April or June exam 2017. Ms. Hathaway made a motion to suspend Mr. Stull's license until he takes the registered exam. Mr. Azzam seconded the motion and all was in favor.

**Henry Arellano** – hearing – Mr. Arellano was not present. He was issued an apprentice license 6/26/15 with an expiration on 12/26/16. He should have taken the April or June exam 2017. Ms. Hathaway made a motion to suspend Mr. Arellano license until he takes the registered exam. Mr. Azzam seconded the motion and all was in favor.

**Cas Pang** – hearing – Mr. Stull was not present. He was issued an apprentice license 9/11/15 with an expiration on 03/11/16. He should have taken the April or June exam 2017. Ms. Hathaway made a motion to suspend Mr. Pang's license until he takes the registered exam. Mr. Azzam seconded the motion and all was in favor.

Andre Diaz, DeAngelio Bert, William Lightner, Joseph Stull, Henry Arellano, and Cas Pang NO SHOWED.

**NABBA Conference** – Ms. Hathaway shared that she feels this is an important conference to attend. There is so much information learned and shared. Mr. Azzam made a motion to elect Nathaniel LaShore, Nancy Hathaway, and Antinette Maestas to attend the NABBA conference September 17-21, 2017 in Charleston, SC, Ms. Hathaway seconded and all was in favor.

Public Comment

Ms. Hathaway made a motion to adjourn the meeting, Mr. Azzam seconded and all was in favor.

There being no further business before the Board the meeting was adjourned.
