

CLASSIFICATIONS OF NEVADA BARBERS

NEVADA STUDENT BARBER

Student Barbers must complete 1,500 hours of Barber School to become eligible for an Apprentice Barber Examination. Completed school hours from states other than Nevada will count towards the required hours, pending verification of hours.

NEVADA APPRENTICE BARBER

Apprentice Barbers have completed 1,500 hours of Barber School and passed the Apprentice Examination. Apprentice Barbers must work alongside a Registered Barber.

After working for 18 months as an Apprentice Barber, you become eligible and must take the Registered Barber Examination.

Restrictions: Apprentice Barbers may not work independently.

NEVADA REGISTERED BARBER

Registered Barbers have completed 18 months of work as an Apprentice Barber and passed the Registered Barber Examination.

Restrictions: None - Registered Barbers are eligible to work independently.

NEVADA BARBER INSTRUCTOR

Barber Instructors must have three years of licensure as a Registered Barber in Nevada. In addition, 600 hours of instructor training is also required prior to being eligible for the Instructor Examination.

BARBER PATH: CURRENT BARBERS FROM DIFFERENT STATES

**DO YOU HAVE FIVE OR MORE YEARS OF
WORKING AS LICENSED BARBER
IN LICENSED BARBERSHOPS?**

STEP 1

You are eligible to become a Registered Barber by Endorsement. We require two sworn affidavits and will verify your license with your State's Barber Board.

STEP 2

Upon completion of your application and verification of your experience, you will be issued a Registered Barber License. The cost is \$60

NO

STEP 1

You must complete 1,500 hours of Barber School to graduate and become eligible for the Apprentice Examination. Completed school hours from states other than Nevada will count towards the required hours, pending verification of hours.

STEP 2

After passing your Apprentice Examination, you are now an Apprentice Barber. Apprentice Barbers must work alongside a Registered Barber.

After working for 18 months as an Apprentice Barber, you become eligible and must take the Registered Barber Examination.

STEP 3

After passing your Registered Barber Examination, you are now a Registered Barber. Renew your Registered Barber License every two years.

BARBER PATH: COSMETOLOGY CROSSOVER APPLICANTS

DO YOU HAVE A CURRENT NEVADA COSMETOLOGY LICENSE?

STEP 1

You must complete or have completed a total of 400 hours of Barber School, either through Nevada or another state to become eligible for a Registered Barber Examination.

STEP 2

After passing your Registered Barber Examination, you are now a Registered Barber. Renew your Registered Barber License every two years.

NO

STEP 1

You must complete 1,500 hours of Barber School to graduate and become eligible for the Apprentice Examination. Completed school hours from states other than Nevada will count towards the required hours, pending verification of hours.

STEP 2

After passing your Apprentice Examination, you are now an Apprentice Barber. Apprentice Barbers must work alongside a Registered Barber.

After working for 18 months as an Apprentice Barber, you become eligible and must take the Registered Barber Examination.

STEP 3

After passing your Registered Barber Examination, you are now a Registered Barber. Renew your Registered Barber License every two years.

BARBER PATH: FOREIGN COUNTRY APPLICANTS

HAVE YOU COMPLETED 1500 HOURS OF BARBER SCHOOL IN ANOTHER COUNTRY?

STEP 1

Your Barber School transcripts from your home country must be translated into English by a certified translator. The board will review your hours to determine if you meet the 1,500 hour requirement.

STEP 2

All foreign applicants are required to complete 250 hours of Barber School, regardless of experience. Upon completion of your Barber School hours, you will become eligible for the Apprentice Examination.

STEP 3

After passing your Apprentice Examination, you are now an Apprentice Barber. Apprentice Barbers must work alongside a Registered Barber.

After working for 18 months as an Apprentice Barber, you become eligible and must take the Registered Barber Examination.

STEP 4

After passing your Registered Barber Examination, you are now a Registered Barber. Renew your Registered Barber License every two years.

NO

STEP 1

You must complete 1,500 hours of Barber School to graduate and become eligible for the Apprentice Examination. Completed school hours from states other than Nevada will count towards the required hours, pending verification of hours.

STEP 2

After passing your Apprentice Examination, you are now an Apprentice Barber. Apprentice Barbers must work alongside a Registered Barber.

After working for 18 months as an Apprentice Barber, you become eligible and must take the Registered Barber Examination.

STEP 3

After passing your Registered Barber Examination, you are now a Registered Barber. Renew your Registered Barber License every two years.

BARBER PATH: NO PREVIOUS EXPERIENCE

STEP 1

Your barber career starts at Barber School. You must complete 1,500 hours of Barber School to graduate and become eligible for the Apprentice Examination. Completed school hours from states other than Nevada will count towards the required hours, pending verification of hours.

STEP 2

After passing your Apprentice Examination, you are now an Apprentice Barber. Apprentice Barbers must work alongside a Registered Barber.

After working for 18 months as an Apprentice Barber, you become eligible and must take the Registered Barber Examination.

STEP 3

After passing your Registered Barber Examination, you are now a Registered Barber.

STEP 4

Renew your Registered Barber License every two years.

BARBER PATH: LICENSED INSTRUCTOR

STEP 1

Barber Instructors must have three years of licensure as a Registered Barber in Nevada. In addition, 600 hours of instructor training is also required prior to being eligible for the Instructor Examination.

STEP 2

Complete 600 hours of Instructor Training in a Barber School to become eligible for the Instructor Examination.

STEP 3

After passing your Instructor Examination, you are now a Licensed Instructor.

STEP 4

Renew your Instructor License every two years.
