



Model Standards

Models must have sufficient facial hair on all parts of the face and neck (side burns, cheeks, lip, and neck), to demonstrate all phases of a facial shave.

The minimum hair length, top, and crown area, must be at least 3.5 inches in length. Curly hair models must be at least 2 inches in length. Outline nape area at least 1.5 inches in length.

It is your responsibility that the model meets all the requirements.

A model that does not meet the requirements may be disqualified, to act as a model, or cost you deductions in points.

A model can not be a registered barber, apprentice barber, student of any Barber School, instructor of any Barber School, or Interpreter.

Please read and understand this.

It is your responsibility to make sure your model meets all the requirements.

If a model is disqualified, you will forfeit all money paid to the Nevada State Barber Board.

If you have a question on a model, you may bring them by any Board member's office to have them checked before the examination.
