Minutes – May 31, 2020 – Business Meeting

President Nathaniel LaShore called the meeting to order on Sunday, May 31, 2020, the time was 4:30 P.M. at the Masterpiece Barber School, located at 3510 East Bonanza Road, Las Vegas, Nevada.

Board members Ms. Nancy Hathaway, Mr. Nathaniel LaShore, Mr. Johnnie Williams, and Secretary/Treasurer Antinette Maestas. Mr. Azzam was not present.

No comment from the public.

Ms. Maestas swore everyone in that were present for hearings.

The agenda was reviewed and approved as posted. Ms. Hathaway made a motion to approve the agenda and Mr. Williams seconded. All was in favor.

Ms. Maestas swore everyone in that were present for hearings.

Ms. Hathaway made a motion to dispense of the reading of the minutes for the February 9, 2020 and the March 30, 2020 Business Meeting since everyone had copies and they had been read. The motion included to accept the minutes as submitted. Mr. Williams seconded the motion and all was in favor.

Ms. Hathaway made a motion to dispense of the reading of the 3rd quarter financial report, Mr. Williams seconded and all was in favor.

Officers Report

1. Ms. Hathaway reported that she has been absolutely in sane trying to get everyone open. She would like to thank everyone for all the hard work to get us open again.
2. Mr. LaShore reported that he too has been working hard to get things going again after the quarantine.
3. Mr. Johnnie Williams agreed with everyone that these have been some trying time.

Old Business

Ms. Maestas reported that the Attorney is working on the Injunction against Gear Heads in Reno advertising as a Barber Shop. The Attorney is working on the final paperwork and has informed her that as soon as it is done he will send it to her to be signed and move forward with it.

Ms. Maestas reported to the Board that she had reviewed another packet to be completed and sent back to the Sunset Review Committee. They are trying to finalize their report to be able to report to the Legislative during the next Session.

Ms. Maestas reported to the Board about distance learning for the schools. The only report she received was from Mr. Byron and he stated that it did not work good for his school. He had very low participation.

Ms. Maestas reported that the Guidelines that were set for COVID were sent out to every barber shop and school in Nevada. Ms. Hathaway posted them on Social Media. Everyone should be following them.

New Business

Marcus Hunt hearing – Mr. Hunt wants to go to school and has a felony on his record. In 2010 he was convicted of robbery with a deadly weapon. He was released December 11, 2019. He will be done with parole in December of 2022. All his paperwork was in order. Ms. Hathaway made a motion to allow him to start school and Mr. Williams seconded the motion all was in favor.

Eddie Stevenson hearing – Mr. Stevenson came before the Board to be able to exam in the State of Nevada. He has 2 felonies on his record. In 2006 he got charged with possession of cocaine, in 2013 he got charged with carrying a weapon. He did 2 ½ months in county jail. He completed barber school in California. Ms. Hathaway made a motion to allow him to exam in Nevada providing he has a drug test prior to exam. Mr. Williams seconded the motion all was in favor.

Shane Taylor hearing – Mr. Taylor came before the board to be able to exam in the State of Nevada. In 2007 he was charged with forgery. He did 1 year in prison and he was dismissed from probation 2015. Ms. Hathaway made a motion to allow Mr. Taylor to exam in Nevada providing he complete a 250 hour refresher course due to the fact that he has not barbered in 5 years. Mr. Williams seconded the motion all was in favor.

Antwaine Johnson hearing – Mr. Johnson came before the board because he wants to exam in the State of Nevada. He has a felony on his record. The felony was in September 2019. He was charged with conspiracy robbery. He served 3 ½ weeks and 5 year's probation. He is on probation for 5 years and has a probation officer. Ms. Hathaway made a motion to allow Mr. Johnson to attend school, Mr. Williams seconded the motion and all was in favor.

Tyrone McDonald – Mr. McDonald came before the Board because he want to exam in the State of Nevada. He falsified his application. He had falsified dates on his work experience. Mr. McDonald claims he had Kentucky license and switched them to Indiana. He had no proof of working as a Barber. He was asked if he had tax returns and he said he only had 3 years. Ms. Hathaway asked Mr. McDonald to get proof that he had 5 year's experience as a barber and come back before the Board.

Ismael Vazquez – Mr. Vazquez came before the Board because he wants to go to school. He has not started school yet, but with his work schedule he knows he cannot finish school within the year time. He is requesting 18 months to be able to attend school. Ms. Hathaway asked him if he had this approved

from his school. He responded that the school told him they would work with him if the Board allowed it. Ms. Hathaway made a motion to allow Mr. Vazquez to have 18 months to complete school only if the school approves this. Mr. Williams seconded the motion all was in favor.

Ernesto Castro – Mr. Castro came before the Board because he is over on his 1 year of attending school. He started school March 2019 he should have been done by March 2020 but he had to withdraw because of work schedule. After discussion, he said he would be done by the July 15, 2020 deadline to take the August 2, 2020 exam. Ms. Hathaway made a motion to allow him to continue school and take the August 2, 2020 exam, Mr. Williams seconded the motion and all was in favor.

Luis Garcia – Mr. Garcia came before the Board because he is over on his 1 year of attending school. He started school February 2019. He has about 12 hours to be done. He is over the 1 year because of financial reasons. Ms. Hathaway made a motion to allow Mr. Garcia to finish school and test in August 2020, Mr. Williams seconded the motion and all was in favor.

Alejandro Madrigal – Mr. Madrigal came before the Board because he is over his 1 year of attending school. He had financial problems and personal problems. Ms. Hathaway made a motion to allow Mr. Madrigal to continue school, finish school and take the August 2, 2020 exam. Mr. Williams seconded the motion and all was in favor.

Robert Bledsoe – Mr. Bledsoe started school November 2017 and finished school August 2018. He fell into financial hardship and could not pay his school off. He has been out of school for almost 2 years. Ms. Hathaway made a motion to let Mr. Bledsoe take a 250 hour refresher course and then take the exam. Mr. Williams seconded the motion and all was in favor.

Angel Gutierrez – Mr. Gutierrez started school March 2019 and he has about 1058 hours. He did some distance learning during quarantine. He fell into financial hardship due to a car accident and he didn't have a car. Has about 400 hours to finish. He was going to school part time. He asked the Board if he could do the October exam. Ms. Hathaway asked for some proof about the car accident she states he only has about 1000 hours in over a year's time. Ms. Hathaway made a motion to have Mr. Gutierrez continue school and come back before the Board in August to see where he is at with his hours. If he is showing that he is regularly attending school he can test in October. Mr. Williams seconded the motion and all was in favor. Ms. Maestas informed Mr. Gutierrez that he would need to submit a letter before July 1, 2020 requesting to be put on the August agenda. He agreed that he would.

Alexander Aniciete – Mr. Aniciete started school March of 2019 and he is over his 1 year due to medical reasons. He was hospitalized for some time. He has approximately 100 hours before he finished. Ms. Hathaway made a motion to allow Mr. Aniciete to continue school and take the August 2, 2020 exam, Mr. Williams seconded the motion and all was in favor.

The Art of Barbering Barber School – Mr. Ray Lewis came before the Board to ask what the criteria is to be able to host the Barber Examination. Ms. Hathaway asked Mr. Lewis to write a letter of proposal to the Board letting the Board know what the school has to offer for hosting the exam. For example how many sinks, chairs, etc. Mr. Lewis said he would write a proposal letter and submit it to the Board.

Eric Young – Mr. Young came before the Board for a citation he was issued on October 31, 2020. The Board has heard Mr. Young at the January 2020 Board meeting. This was tabled because he wanted to bring witnesses back to this meeting. Mr. Young did not bring witnesses because 1 was in California and

the other one he could not get ahold of him. Ms. Maestas states that Mr. Young had told her that he had an individual working there but he only had a license from New Mexico. Mr. Young stated that the individual told him that he had registered with the Board to take the test. Mr. Young stated that the individual owed him money so he kept his tools. Ms. Hathaway stated that Mr. Young admitted he had the individual working. Ms. Hathaway made a motion that the fine stands. Mr. LaShore seconded the motion and all was in favor.

Carl Littles – Mr. Littles came before the Board to get approval for a Barber School location. He presented the Board with floor plans. The address is 5812 S. Pecos, Las Vegas, Nevada. They will have approximately 6000 square feet, 40 chairs, and a sink for every chair. They plan on starting construction upon approval. They plan on being done about March 2021. Ms. Hathaway made a motion to approve the location at 5812 S. Pecos Las Vegas, Nevada. Mr. Williams seconded the motion and all was in favor.

John Haynes, Maurcie Ford, Michael Paige, Farren Collins, Karl Cage, and Greg Warner no showed for hearing.

Ms. Hathaway made a motion to pursue hiring inspectors for the extra help. She would like to get this process started and hire 2 inspectors for the South and 1 inspector for the North. Mr. Williams seconded the motion and all was in favor. Under Discussion Mr. LaShore agreed that during these trying times we need to be out checking on these shops making sure they are following the Guidelines set.


Ms. Hathaway states that the Board has had much interest in re doing and updating the Board's website to be able to allow for credit card payments and more online accessibility. She states that the Board has gathered 3 quotes on this project. After looking at the presentations she feels the Continental Management Consultants is well in the Board's budget. Not only are they in the price range, she feels that the security of their product is outstanding. The price is from \$8,000-\$12,000. The price would be determined after them looking at the Board's system and how much content the Board would like added. They are requesting ½ down when the contract is signed and the remainder at completion of the project. Ms. Hathaway made a motion to hire Continental Management Consultants to redo and update the Boards website to make things more online accessible and user friendly. Mr. Williams seconded the motion and all was in favor.

Ms. Hathaway made a motion to adjourn the meeting, Mr. Williams seconded and all was in favor.

There being no further business before the Board the meeting was adjourned.


