Minutes – February 9, 2020 – Business Meeting

President Nathaniel LaShore called the meeting to order on Sunday, February 9, 2020, the time was 3:00 P.M. at the Masterpiece Barber School, located at 3510 East Bonanza Road, Las Vegas, Nevada.

Board members Ms. Nancy Hathaway, Mr. Nataniel LaShore, Mr. Johnnie Williams, Mr. Ihsan Azzam and Secretary/Treasurer Antinette Maestas.

Ms. Maestas swore everyone in that were present for hearings.

The agenda was reviewed and approved as posted. Ms. Hathaway made a motion to approve the agenda and Mr. Williams seconded. There was discussion on this item. All was in favor.

Ms. Hathaway made a motion to dispense of the reading of the minutes for the October 6, 2019 Business Meeting since everyone had copies and they had been read. The motion included to accept the minutes as submitted. Mr. Williams seconded the motion and all was in favor.

Ms. Hathaway made a motion to dispense of the reading of the 2nd quarter financial report, Mr. Williams seconded and all was in favor.

Officers Report

1. Ms. Hathaway reported that she has been busy up North. Doing business as usual. There has been some talk about maybe a barber school going in but they have not come in for an application.
2. Mr. LaShore reported that he has been doing business as usual. Staying busy inspecting.
3. Mr. Johnnie Williams has been busy and he has been doing inspections. He states that he has asked Mr. LaShore to go with him on a few inspections because of people running out the back door, and with problem shops for security purposes also.

New Business

Christopher Monthaven hearing – Mr. Monthaven wants to go to school and has a felony on his record. April 2015 he was convicted of a felony for robbery. He served 5 years in prison and was released December 10, 2019. He is on 3 months' probation. He did several classes while incarcerated. All his

paperwork was in order. Ms. Hathaway made a motion to allow him to start school and Mr. Williams seconded the motion all was in favor.

LeAndre Patrick hearing – Mr. Patrick came before the Board to be able to attend school in the State of Nevada. He has 2 felonies on his record. In 2015 he got a Class D felony. He was on probation then got caught with a fire arm in 2016. He was let out December 2019. He is in a half-way house until April 22, 2020. He is on parole for 3 years. Ms. Hathaway made a motion to allow him to start school and Mr. Williams seconded the motion all was in favor.

Christian Truss hearing – Mr. Truss came before the board to be able to attend school. He was charged with a felony in 2004 for burglary. He was incarcerated for 11 months. The case was closed September 2016. He graduated from UNLV in 2017 he is applying for his masters in social work at UNLV. All his paperwork was in order. Ms. Hathaway made a motion to allow him to start school and Mr. Williams seconded the motion all was in favor.

Markiston Page hearing – Mr. Page came before the board because he wants to go to school. He has a felony on his record. The felony was in April 2010. He was charged with possession and possession with the intent to sale. He served a year and a half in prison. He was released in 2012 with a honorable discharge. Ms. Hathaway made a motion to allow Mr. Page to attend school, Mr. Williams seconded the motion and all was in favor.

Ezekiel Gilbert – Mr. Gilbert came before the Board because he want to go to school. He has a felony on his record. In October 2016 he was charged with pandering. He did no jail time he started probation November 2018. He was sentenced to 5 years of probation but feels he will be done in about a year. Ms. Hathaway made a motion to allow him to start school and Mr. Williams seconded the motion all was in favor.

Richard Junco – Mr. Junco came before the Board because he wants to go to school. In 2013 he was charged for burglary. He did no jail time. He was on probation for 1 year. The case was closed 2016. Ms. Hathaway made a motion to suspend his license and Mr. Williams seconded the motion all was in favor.

Michael Page – Mr. Page came before the Board because of a felony on his record and he wants to test in Nevada for his barber license. In 2005 he was charged with battery and a DUI felony. He completed all the programs while in jail for 9 months. He knows he was charged with another felony but can't remember. He has paperwork of release dates for several things. He has been licensed in Indiana as a barber and is working in a mall barber shop in Indiana. He knows he did probation for about 3 years. Going through all his paperwork Ms. Hathaway states there are several discharges on the paperwork he has brought. Ms. Hathaway states she does not feel that there is not enough paperwork to make a determination on this case. While continuing through the paperwork, Ms. Hathaway found release dates from 1997 Mr. Page states those were his dads charges. There is not enough to make a determination. Ms. Hathaway made a motion that at this time there is not enough correct paperwork to make a determination the request will be denied until he can prove his case. Mr. Williams seconded the motion and all was in favor.

Loren Bridges – Mr. Bridges came before the Board because he wants to test in Nevada and has a felony on his record. He is licensed in Ohio. In 2004 he was charged with carrying a weapon concealed. He got pulled over, he was carrying a gun while driving with a suspended license and tried to flee. He did no jail

time and was on probation for 2 years. The case was closed in 2006. Ms. Hathaway made a motion to allow Mr. Bridges to test in Nevada, Mr. Williams seconded the motion and all was in favor.

Eric Young— Mr. Young came before the Board because he was issued a citation on October 31, 2019. He was cited for NRS 643.190. Mr. Williams stated that he went into his shop to do a inspection. There was a station set up with no license on it. When Mr. Williams asked Mr. Young where the license for this station were everything went bad. Mr. Young stated that he didn't know Mr. Williams was working for the Board that day. He stated that there was a barber working there but he was not there he is in New Mexico. He states that those were his tools. Mr. Williams stated that when he went in there were 2 individuals there and 1 person eased out of the door. Mr. Young started with other things that did not pertain to this citation. He states that he has individuals as witnesses. Ms. Hathaway made a motion to table this until the next meeting. Mr. Azzam seconded the motion and all was in favor.

Rahsaan Hawkins — Mr. Hawkins was supposed to take the February 9, 2020 exam for his registered barber license. He missed it due to having a stroke and being in the hospital. He has not been able to work. He had documents from the hospital. Ms. Hathaway made a motion to allow Mr. Hawkins to take the April exam and not suspend his license. Mr. Williams seconded the motion and all was in favor.

Clifford Wallace — Mr. Wallace was issued an apprentice license April 2018, he should have taken December 2019 or February 2020 exam. We did not hear from him to take this exam. Ms. Hathaway made a motion to suspend his license, Mr. Williams seconded the motion and all was in favor.

Wesley Wagner - Mr. Wagner was issued an apprentice license April 2018, he should have taken December 2019 or February 2020 exam. We did not hear from him to take this exam. Ms. Hathaway made a motion to suspend his license, Mr. Williams seconded the motion and all was in favor.

Terrance Hawkins and Germil Childs no showed for hearing.

Lance Rankin, and Ryan Maynard took the exam and no need to hear them.

Ms. Hathaway reported that Gear Head Salon is the salon in Reno advertising a barber shop and refuses to take it down. After following the AG's advice, 3 fines were issued. The Attorney needs the Boards permission to issue a cease and desist letter. If he does not comply after the 30 days, the AG's office would need permission to file an injunction. Ms. Hathaway made a motion for the AG's office to send a cease and desist if there is no response after 30 days, then the AG's office will move forward with an injunction. Mr. Williams seconded the motion and all was in favor.

Sunset Review – Ms. Maestas reminded everyone that there is going to be a meeting of the Sunset Review Committee. The Board will be on that agenda. The meeting will be held February 21, 2020 at 9:00 A.M. it will be at the Grant Sawyer Building and teleconferenced in Carson City.

NIC – Ms. Maestas states that there was a change in the NIC staff and the proctor that we were using to proctor our Instructors exam is no longer with the company. NIC has informed us that we must use 2 proctors. The proctors have sent in a proposal for the board to approve. They are asking for \$500 per person for compensation. We will have to reimburse air fare x 2, hotel room up to \$200, and \$50 per person for food. So basically it will cost the Board about \$1400 per exam. They also need 6 week advance notice. Ms. Maestas states that there is no contract required. Ms. Hathaway made a motion to

accept the travel package presented by Patrick and Lyndell Tabler-Ulsh and look into other companies that may offer these services. Mr. Williams seconded the motion and all was in favor.

Instructors date – Ms. Maestas stated that she needs the Boards permission to schedule the Instructors exam. Ms. Hathaway made a motion to allow Ms. Maestas to schedule the Instructor’s exam as soon as possible, Mr. Williams seconded the motion and all was in favor.

NABBA – No Board members were nominated to attend the mid-winter conference in Dallas, Texas the end of February.

Public Comment

Ms. Gwen Braimoh stated that she thinks the inspectors should take pictures when doing shop inspections. It’s more solid. She also stated she appreciated the Board approving the proctors for the Instructors exam because she has 2 instructors that will be ready to test.

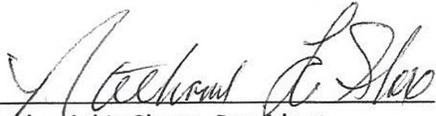
Ms. Hathaway made a motion to adjourn the meeting, Mr. Williams seconded and all was in favor.
