This has been a difficult email to send, and has been in progress for quite some time. I am a student at The Art of Barbers and have had many issues since enrolling last August. However, my biggest issues have been with Mr. Byron and the undue behavior directed towards women. Below are person incidents that I have experienced throughout my time here at the school. Due to these incidents, I do not feel safe around Mr. Byron. It has come to the point where I will not attend school if he is there. For the most part, my concerns have not been taken as seriously as they should and that is has left me even more wary. It also has been a contributing factor in how long it has taken me to send this email.

I would like to participate in the petition for a meeting with the board regarding this situation. At the end of the day, I just want to get my license to be a barber. But the safety of myself and the other females, customer and student, is a larger concern.

Your time and help is greatly appreciated and I look forward to hearing from you.

Incident Examples:

8/11/21

This was the day I started with the school. When I arrived, I was first excitedly greeted by Mr. Byron. He, along with some of the Nevada's First students were working on the portable sinks. At the time, I didn't know that he was a part of the school, yet alone the owner. So, I kind of wrote off the suggestive look and greeting that was given. Not more than 2 hours later, I came to learn his role within the school. He called all the students to the back, where the women's restroom is located, and proceeded to point out that I was a woman and the male students were no longer allowed to use that restroom. This "conversation" lasted 10-15 minutes. From that point on in the day, Mr. B made sure to let the entire class know that I was a female. He took several opportunities to pull the class aside to rant about one thing or another, for upwards of 45 minutes, where he would take every opportunity to point out that I was a female. This was already an overwhelming day, seeing as it was my first day in a school trying to learn a trade that was entirely new to me. It wasn't made any easier when I was being unnecessarily singled out for something that was obvious to everyone present.

8/31-10/31

Throughout this period of time there were a few instances that became uncomfortable. The first being when Mr. Byron pulled me, another student, and the teacher's aid out of the school for another one of his lectures. The school is located at one end of The Boulevard Mall. Mr. Byron took the three of us all the way to the other end of the mall next to the UEI school. He then spent 30 minutes discussing the importance of advertising through the use of business cards and how we need to be marketing to the UEI students. During this "conversation," Mr. Byron took the opportunity to, leeringly, check me out. It was the action you see in movies when a pretty girl walks by a group of guys. Shocked, disturbed, and slightly angered, I looked to the other student who had the same look I imagine I had on my face. I felt exposed, objectified, singled out, cornered, and disgusted. The hairs on the back of my neck stood on end and I wanted nothing more than to leave the situation.

After that particular encounter, Mr. Byron would frequent the school. He would stop by for an hour or two once a week or so. During his time at the school, he would make a point to, what felt like, search me out and call out my name as many times as possible. It was so aggressive, that the other students started making jokes about it. One of the days, I intentionally counted the number of times Mr. Byron did this. In 20 minutes, he had called my name 5 times, 3 of which he decided to get within my personal space and ask how I was. Every time I would hear my name, a sense of dread fell over me and I just wanted to leave.

There was another instance when Mr. Byron was at the school working on another project. He was putting together

COVID screens. At the time, I was standing in a small group of maybe 2-3 other, male students. Mr. Byron said, "Madison. Come here." He then told me to "help" him put together the screen. The entirety of my time doing the task, he stood over me and pointing out if I did anything incorrectly. I worked on the screens for 5 minutes, before one of the other instructors stepped in and asked another student to take over. That instructor pulled me aside and let me know that Mr. Byron's behavior was not acceptable, which is why he had the other student take over. Being asked to help wasn't the problem. I am always willing to help others, but the way that it was handled made me feel, again, singled out. And it felt as though Mr. Byron was trying to assert his dominance. According to the actions, and statement of the other instructor, it appeared that way as well.

The most uncomfortable encounter was on a Saturday after we had closed. It was around 5pm when Mr. Byron stopped by the school. At this point in time, I had had enough experiences with Mr. B to know it was better to try to stay hidden. Which is exactly what I attempted to do when he called all of the students over for another lecture. This particular topic was about germs, COVID, and hand washing. Throughout the rant, I did my best to stand behind the taller students and the posted mirrors that are spread throughout the school. But Mr. Byron made the effort to search me out. It was almost comical, in the way he snaked around looking for me. The reason I know he was specifically searching for me was because of the comment that was made next. He said, "Madison, you're in the touching business now." As he said it he looked me up and down just as he had weeks previously. Every part of me wanted to disappear in that moment. I wanted to leave and scrub off a layer of skin. The comment in and of itself was suggestive, then to look at me the way he, and to top it off do the entire thing in front of all of the male students. I have never felt so uncomfortable in my life.

There was another incident a few weeks afterwards. Mr. Byron and some of the Nevada's First students stopped by for a couple of hours. I was standing outside of the school, between two of our school's students. It was around 1pm. Mr. B had told his students that it was time to leave and headed out himself. A few minutes later they walked back into the school for some reason or another. This time, on the way out, Mr. Byron looked around at the students standing outside. He went around fist bumping the Nevada's First students that had permission to stay, and then headed straight towards me. Without paying any attention to the students standing directly beside me, Mr. B cornered me and gave me no choice but to fist bump him as well before heading back to his school. The students standing beside me were not even recognized as physically being there as well. I immediately went inside and washed my hands, because of how disgusting I felt.

1/14

Students received an email at 7:14 am that we must all arrive at school by 8:45 for a mandatory COVID update. This update wasn't even discussed until later in the morning around 11:30am. During this meeting we were told that we would not be allowed to attend school until we provided a negative COVID test, even if you were vaccinated. Mr. Byron also used this time to degrade all the students. Saying that we were lazy, unsanitary, and disrespectful. That we all spend too much time on our phones and that he was watching all of our screens from the cameras located in the school. As the lecture went on, Mr. B began to raise his voice as if we were children being punished by a parent. Throughout the entirety of the conversation, which was originally about COVID, Mr. walked around without a mask and getting within 3 feet of students.

2/22

We were doing a mock state board exam from 8:45-11. As the students who were participating were nearing the end of the exam, Mr. Byron entered the building through the back of the school. Upon the completion of the exam, Mr. Byron had all of the nonparticipating students go around and take photos of all of the completed state board practicals. He then proceeded to lecture us on how everyone who participated would have failed the exam if it were the real deal. He did so by degrading every student in the building, saying that we were lazy, uncaring, and disrespectful. That we didn't deserve to pass the state board exam. As the lecture continued, Mr. Byron made the comment that, should we behave to his standards, we will find success, except for the female students who will have to find other means to achieve any success in the industry. This was one of the most frustrating and degrading things that I've heard in a moment. The entire lecture demonstrated a complete lack of respect for all involved.
