Minutes – February 4, 2024 – Regular Business Meeting

President Toby Chavez called the meeting to order on Sunday, February 4, 2024, the time was 1:00 P.M. at the Masterpiece Barber School, located at 3510 East Bonanza Road, Suite 150, Las Vegas, Nevada, 89110.

Ms. Maestas checked in on individuals on teleconference to make sure everyone could hear fine. Mr. Benedict Kargbo and Mr. Darrell Jones were on the phone.

Old Business – None at this time.

New Business

Ms. Maestas was asked by President Chavez to please swear in anyone scheduled for a hearing today. All individuals were sworn in. Ms. Maestas asked anyone on the phone to please raise their right hand and be sworn in.

Benedict Kargbo - Mr. Kargbo was on the phone for a teleconference hearing. He is asking for an extension of time of schooling. He stated that he fell behind because of his work schedule. Ms. Maestas

told the Board her records show that Mr. Kargbo started school on January 11, 2023, as of December 31, 2023 the records show he has 954 hours. She stated she does not have the January time sheets yet. Mr. Foley made a motion to grant Mr. Kargbo a 6 month from today to finish his schooling. Mr. Azzam seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Darrell Jones – Mr. Jones was on the phone for a teleconference hearing. Mr. Jones has a felony on his record and wants to be licensed by endorsement. Ms. Maestas states that he was going to be here today and he missed his flight from Kansas City yesterday. He did send his paperwork. After looking over his paperwork, Mr. Foley made a motion to allow Mr. Jones to be able to move forward with his endorsement. Mr. Azzam seconded the motion. Motion passed.

After checking in on the phone there was no other individuals on the phone.

Jevon Oglesby was not present today. Ms. Maestas states that Mr. Oglesby called and wanted to reschedule the hearing to a later date.

Adam Sosa hearing – Mr. Sosa came before the Board to be able to attend Barber School. He received a felony charge in 2011 for burglary. He served 2 ½ years in prison. He was released from parole in 2014. He completed the Hope for Prisoners program and they are paying for his schooling. After reviewing the paperwork, Mr. Foley made a motion for Mr. Sosa to attend barber school, Mr. Azzam seconded the motion. Motion passed

Frisco Lopez – Mr. Lopez came before the Board to be able to be allowed to attend Barber School. He has felonies on his record. He served 4 years in prison. He was released August 26, 2022. In 2019 and 2020. He was charged with discharging a firearm, and possession of a stolen vehicle. He was released from parole on January 20, 2024. He completed Hope for prisoners and took several classes while incarcerated. After reviewing all paperwork, Mr. Foley made a motion to allow Mr. Lopez to attend Barber School. Mr. Azzam seconded the motion. Motion Passed.

Gian Alberto - Mr. Alberto came before for an extension for school. Ms. Maestas stated that Mr. Alberto started school on January 19, 2022 and as of July 29, 2023 he was done with his hours. Ms. Maestas stated she does not know where his services are at because she does not have those records. The Board asked Mr. Alberto how much time he needed to finish his services. Mr. Alberto states that he would be fine with 3 months. Mr. Foley made a motion to grant Mr. Alberto a 3 month extension to complete services. Mr. Azzam seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Alexander Tellez - Mr. Tellez came to before the Board for an extension for school. He stated he shares custody with his children and he has to leave early. Mr. Foley made a motion to allow Mr. Tellez a 6 month from today extension to finish his hours and pay off his school. Mr. Azzam seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Veronica Velez – Ms. Velez came before the Board for approval to take the examination. She went over her time to finish school. She had personal things happen in her life. Ms. Velez stated she is done with her schooling now. Ms. Maestas states she does have a completed application on file. Mr. Foley made a motion to allow Ms. Velez to take the examination. Mr. Azzam seconded the motion. Motion passed.

NABBA CONFERENCE – Mr. Chavez stated he would not be able to attend, and Mr. Foley stated he would not be able to attend. Ms. Maestas stated that the deadline for registration had passed before

the meeting today. Mr. Foley made a motion that there would be no delegates from Nevada attending the Midwinter Conference since the deadline had passed. Mr. Azzam seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Ms. Maestas checked the phone lines again. There was no one on the lines.


Mr. Foley made a motion for agenda items 10, 12, 13, 15, and 20 to be denied with the option of rescheduling. Mr. Azzam seconded the motion and all were in favor. They were not in attendance.

Public Comment There was no public comment.

Mr. Foley made a motion to adjourn the meeting, Mr. Azzam seconded and all was in favor. The time was 1:27 P.M.

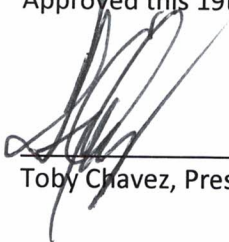
There being no further business before the Board the meeting was adjourned.

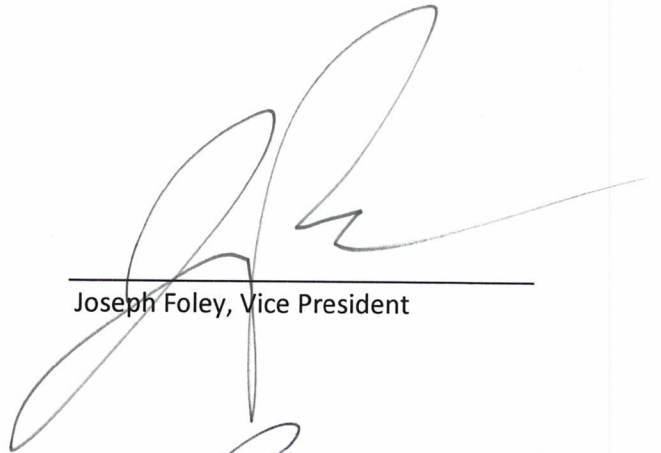

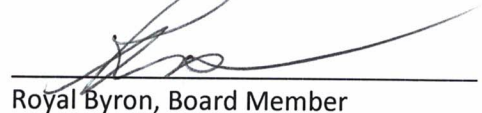
