**Minutes –February 1, 2026 – Regular Business Meeting**

President Toby Chavez called the meeting to order on Sunday, February 1, 2026, the time was 2:00 P.M. at the Masterpiece Barber School, located at 3510 East Bonanza Road, Suite 150, Las Vegas, Nevada, 89110.

Roll call was taken and present were, Mr. Chavez, Mr. Foley was teleconferenced, Mr. Azzam, Mr. Raymon Green, Secretary/Treasurer Ms. Maestas and Mr. Joseph Ostunio the Boards DAG.

Mr. Chavez read the Mission Statement of the Board was read. Our Mission is to ensure that all barbers in Nevada are well qualified, adequately trained, and capable for providing hygienic professional service in a safe and healthy environment.

Public comment – There was no Public Comment.

Mr. Foley made a motion to approve the agenda. Mr. Azzam seconded the motion, a vote was taken and all were in favor. Motion passed.

Mr. Foley made a motion to approve the minutes for the January 27, 2026 meeting. Mr. Azzam seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Mr. Foley made a motion to approve the financial report of the 2nd quarter report 2025/2026. Mr. Chavez seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Ms. Maestas checked in on individuals on teleconference to make sure everyone could hear fine. Mr. Joseph Foley and Mr. Deron William were on the phone.

**Old Business** - Ms. Dasia Clearman came before the Board to revisit her Cool Jet Plasma Pen. She presented on how sanitation would be performed on the Cool Jet Pen. She showed that the tips on the pen are disposal and every client would get a new tip. She feels that she has a barber license and feels she should be able to use this on clients. She is looking for a salon suite that she could set up a different room and use that for her tricology room. She would not be doing barbering in that room. After much

discussion, Mr. Chavez made a motion to deny the request due to the Cool Jet Pen not being in the NRS chapter 643 scope of practice. Mr. Foley seconded the motion a vote was taken and all were in favor.

### **New Business**

Ms. Maestas was asked by President Chavez to please swear in anyone scheduled for a hearing today. All individuals were sworn in. Ms. Maestas asked anyone on the phone to please raise their right hand and be sworn in.

**Manuel Flores Jr.** - Mr. Flores came before the Board because he wants to go to barber school and he received a felony in 2011 for larceny and served 1 ½ years. He was also charged with ownership possession of a fire arm. He did no jail time and served his probation. He is working for a casino and is licensed in Utah. After reviewing the paperwork that was sent in, Mr. Foley made a motion to allow Mr. Flores to attend barber school. Mr. Azzam seconded the motion and all were in favor. Motion Passed.

**Deron Williams** – Mr. Williams teleconferenced with the Board. He wants to attend barber school and has a felony on his record. He received a felony in 2014 for burglary. He served 5 years of prison. He is working at Superior staging part time. He turned in no paperwork. Mr. Foley made a motion to table until next meeting. Mr. Azzam seconded the motion. A vote was taken and all were in favor. Motion Passed. Mr. Chavez stated that Mr. Williams needs all his paperwork in to the office 3 days before the meeting. He will receive a letter with all the information on it.

**Tyler Dew Moore** – Mr. Moore came before the Board he has a felony on his record. He wants to attend barber school. He has 2 felonies when he was 17. He served 40 months in prison. First felony was for battery with a deadly weapon in 2021 and second was for prohibited person with a firearm this happened in 2022. He is on parole until June 2026. He did Hope for Prisoners. Mr. Foley made a motion to allow Mr. Moore to attend barber school. Mr. Azzam seconded the motion. A vote was taken and all were in favor. Motion Passed.

**Josue Santiago** – Mr. Santiago came before the Board he has a felony on his record. He wants to attend barber school. In 2024 he received a felony for attempt to consent a firearm without a permit. He is on parole until March 30, 2026. He is in West care for rehabilitation and he stated he is 31 months clean. He is in Anchor of Hope program. Mr. Foley made a motion to allow Mr. Santiago to attend barber school. Mr. Azzam seconded the motion. A vote was taken and all were in favor.

**Johnny Sotelo** – Mr. Sotelo came before the Board he has a felony on his record and wants to attend barber school. He drove down from Elko and forgot all his paperwork. Mr. Foley made a motion to table until May 3, 2026. Mr. Azzam seconded the motion. A vote was taken and all were in favor. Motion passed. Mr. Green explained to Mr. Sotelo that all the paperwork needed to be in to the office by April 15. Ms. Maestas explained that he can teleconference so that he did not have to make the trip to Vegas.

**Carl Goodwin** – Mr. Goodwin came before the Board to get approval to attend Barber School. He has multiple felonies on his record. In 2003 he received a felony of robbery he was sentenced to 15-36 weeks. In 2008 he received a felony for controlled substance he served 1 year and 1 day in prison. In 2010 he received another controlled substance, later that year he received another robbery with first

degree deadly weapon. In 2017 he received another felony for unlawful possession of a firearm. He served 4 years in prison. In 2021 he was released from everything. Mr. Foley made a motion to allow Mr. Goodwin to be allowed to attend Barber School. Mr. Azzam seconded the motion and all were in favor. Motion Passed.

**Derrick Morales** – Mr. Morales came before the Board to get approval to attend Barber School. He has a felony on his record. He went into prison at 18 years old and he did not bring any paperwork. Mr. Foley made a motion to table this until May 3, 2026 meeting. Mr. Azzam seconded the motion. All were in favor. Motion passed.

**Joshua Acevas** - Mr. Acevas came before the Board to be allowed to get licensed by Endorsement. He has a felony on his record. In 2016 he received a felony for battery and served no jail time. He moved to California and the case remained a felony because he left the State. It should have been a misdemeanor. Because he left the State it stayed a felony. He is licensed in California. Mr. Foley made a motion to allow Mr. Acevas be allowed to get licensed by endorsement. Mr. Azzam seconded the motion the motion all were in favor. Motion Passed.

**Rachel Ashcroft**- Ms. Ashcroft came before the Board to appeal a citation issued on October 28, 2025. She was cited for NRS 643.190. She was operating on an expired barbershop license. She asked for a reduction of the fine. She stated it was not intentional she has been going through a lot of family medical. She was not working at the time. She paid the citation on October 29, 2025. Mr. Foley made a motion to deny the appeal of the citation. Mr. Green stated that how did she get a citation when no one was there. Mr. Azzam stated with the medical hardship we should look at this different. Ms. Maestas informed Mr. Green that because she was advertising as a barber, she was not in a licensed barbershop. This all falls under NRS 643.190. She stated she did not work from April through October. She has all the medical records of her son being in the hospital. Mr. Foley rescinded his motion. Mr. Green made a motion to allow 50% of fine is reduced because of hardship, but also keep the other 50% because it is still a violation. Mr. Foley seconded the motion and all was in favor. Motion Passed. Ms. Maestas asked since she has already paid the entire fine what does she do. DAG Ostunio stated to refund 50% of the citation paid.

**NABBA Midwinter Conference** – Mr. Foley stated he would not be available to attend. Mr. Azzam made a motion to allow Mr. Green, Mr. Chavez, and Ms. Maestas to attend the mid winter conference in Charleston, SC. Mr. Foley seconded the motion. All were in Favor and Motion Passed.

**Inspectors** – Ms. Maestas stated that one of the inspectors resigned from the Inspectors job. There is a position open for the Inspectors job in the South. Mr. Green asked what the qualifications are. They have to be licensed for 5 years and they have to be able to pass a drug test. Ms. Maestas states there are applications from the last hiring. Mr. Azzam made a motion to put the opening on the website for applications. Mr. Foley made a motion. A vote was taken and all were in favor. Motion Passed.

Ms. Maestas asked if anyone was on the phone that has not been heard. There was no one on the phone.

Mr. Foley made a motion for agenda items 11 and 18 to be denied with the option of repetition. Mr. Azzam seconded the motion and all were in favor. They were not in attendance.

**Public Comment** -

Mr. Azzam asked if we could revisit the Chief Executive Administrators salary.  
DAG Ostunio stated that in a few months we are going to be more clear on the Board's finances and that would be a good time to revisit this.

Mr. Foley made a motion to adjourn the meeting, Mr. Azzam seconded and all was in favor. The time was 3:30 P.M.

There being no further business before the Board the meeting was adjourned.

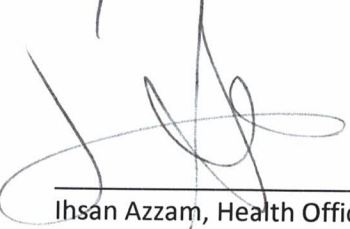
